- Help identify and steward potential donors and fundraising prospects by facilitating introductions and building connections for NFFTT
- Understand and follow MakeWay's review processes and procedures
- Assist with the design, planning and implementation of fundraising events, including dayof support and managing additional event volunteers if required
- Assist with donor stewardship strategies and implementation
- Actively contribute to brainstorming new fundraising

- Contribute to the analysis of the performance of events and other fundraising activities for effectiveness and continued learning
- Attend, actively participate and contribute to sub-committee meetings

Meeting Frequency & Expectations

The Committee will meet once every month and as needed to discuss and review fundraising and communications goals, activities, deliverables and results.
