Candidates must be living in 'Canada.' Given our work with Northern, remote, and Indigenous communities, as well as marginalized communities in urban neighbourhoods, we welcome board members with lived experience in these communities, particularly First Nations, Metis, and Inuit Elders.

Key Responsibilities

- Attend four quarterly board meetings annually, consisting of one two-day in-person meeting and three online meetings, as well as the Annual General Meeting.
- Attend and chair three Finance & Audit Committee online meetings annually.
- Take on the role of Treasurer, working closely with the CFO in being responsible for:
 - Overseeing and maintaining appropriate financial records for MakeWay in accordance with provincial and federal legislation and regulations.
 - Ensuring that accurate financial statements are available to the directors and to other parties as required.



- Help determine and steward the organization's mission and overarching objectives.
- Oversee the organization's financial viability and risk management.
- Uphold appropriate governance processes, including CEO oversight, board succession, and other fiduciary responsibilities.
- Participate in the design and oversight of our long-term vision and strategic framework for MakeWay.
